

Preschool Dress Code

- Tan khakis, khaki sweatpants, khaki shorts or dress pants (no jeans)
- Navy blue long-sleeved or short-sleeved polo shirts or navy blue turtle-neck
- White or blue crew socks
- Sneakers or black/blue/brown “school shoes” (less than 1 inch heel)
- Blue sweatshirts, blue cardigan, or blue sweater vest
- School gym uniform (Purchased from A Stitch in Time)
- No sandals, flip-flops, boots, etc. The children will be very active both indoors and out, and these types of shoes would not be safe. During inclement weather, feel free to send your child in snow/rain boots and include their regular shoes in a plastic bag.

Each student must wear sneakers and the official gym uniform on scheduled physical education days and field trips.

An extra change of clothes including underpants and socks should be sent in on the first day of school. Please put these items in a labeled plastic bag. **Accidents do happen, and your child would be more comfortable in fresh clothes in case of a mishap.**

The school dress code is intended to show a uniform appearance while offering flexibility to families. Also, the classroom does have air-conditioning but can be warm at times. A short sleeved shirt with a sweater/sweatshirt that can be removed would provide the best comfort most days. **Please be sure to carefully label all clothing including coats, gloves, hats, and scarves.**
